

## Lincoln Valley Seventh-day Adventist Cemetery Grave List

This list was not possible without the 1975 list of sixty six individuals that was assembled by Bill Bechthold, Emil Bentz, and Lorraine Werner. Six of the individuals, that they thought were buried here, are not buried here. Karl & Charlotte (Reimche) Schwartz are buried in the McClusky City Cemetery. The two infant girls, Magdalena & Selma, of David & Gottliebena Lemke are buried in Peace Lutheran Cemetery. Katherina (Suelzle) Wall is, most likely, buried someplace in South Dakota. Finally, Lorenz Rothaker was listed twice because someone misread the last name on his gravestone as "Malander". The net sixty individuals on their original list still appear on this one. At this time, eighty individuals have been given an "Ind" (Individual) number, and are therefore counted, as having been buried in this cemetery. There are more than eighty individuals on this list. A word of warning, if I haven't assigned an "Ind" (Individual) number, I don't believe they are buried here. The reason I left them on this list is either because we don't know, for sure, if they are, or are not, buried here, or because, one of the three original lists that I used as source information, thought they were buried here.
